- The shopping center will host more than 70 stores including big names such as Decathlon, H&M and one of the firsts IKEA stores in the region.

Open Kennedy, that will generate 600 new job positions distributed among sales force and management, will have five stories and more than 70 stores. Big players stand out, such as swedish H&M and french sports gear and clothing Decathlon, this last one offering two stories with specialized brands for more than 65 disciplines. Fourth floor will concentrate culinary offerings, while the top floor will be focused on entertainment with the incorporation of the first Chuck E. Cheese in the district.

Aiming the goal of delivering best experience for customers, Open Kennedy will have open-air spaces including a co-work area, a common space for entrepeneurs to offer their products, parking lots to host all kinds of sustainable mobility, an expo area, inclusive playground for children and a space for pets.

Open kennedy will start operating in a gradual manner (it will open with 80% of its proposition). IKEA opening in 2021 will complete the proposition of this new shopping center.
