

BIO Hernán Büchi Candidate to SACI Falabella as Independent Board Member

Hernán Büchi Buc has been a member of the board of directors of S.A.C.I. Falabella since 2003. He is a Civil Engineer from the Universidad of Chile and completed postgraduate studies at Columbia University in the City of New York. Since 1990, Mr. Büchi has advised a number of different governments of Latin America, Eastern Europe and Asia on the design and implementation of economic policy. In 1990, he founded and became Chairman and member of the board of the Institute Liberty and Development, a public policy think tank. He has also been Chairman of the Board of the Center on International Economy of the Liberty and Development Institute, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Universidad del Desarrollo, director of Quiñenco S.A., Madeco S.A., Soquimich S.A. and Consorcio Nacional de Seguros S.A., among others. Mr. Büchi has served for the Government of Chile in different positions including Undersecretary of Economy between 1979 and 1980 and Minister of Finance (1985-1989).
